

**Compliance with Americans with Disabilities Act Regulations
New Construction and Alterations**

1992 House Bill 2602, adopted by the Kansas Legislature, amended several statutes to, among other things, require city building inspectors to enforce the following federal regulations: Nondiscrimination in state and local government services, 28 CFR Part 35, and non discrimination on the basis of disability by public accommodation and commercial facilities, 28 CFR Part 36, as required by the Americans with Disabilities Act of 1990, 42 USCA 12101 et seq., enacted on July 26, 1990.

The state law requires that all new construction and alterations be done in conformance with the federal regulations, including the accessibility guidelines for buildings and facilities that are adopted by the regulations (Appendix A to 29 CFR Part 36). The effective date of the new state law is July 1, 1992.
